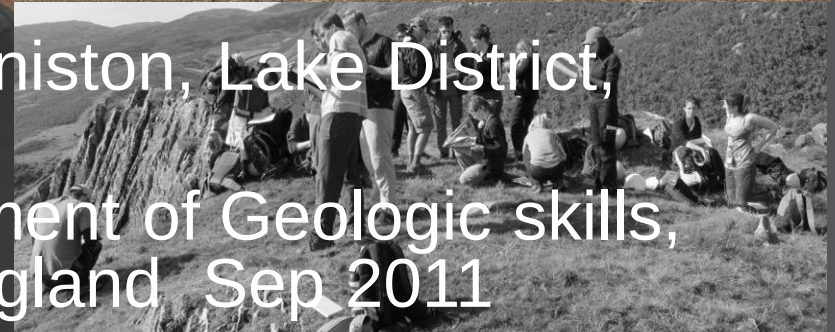
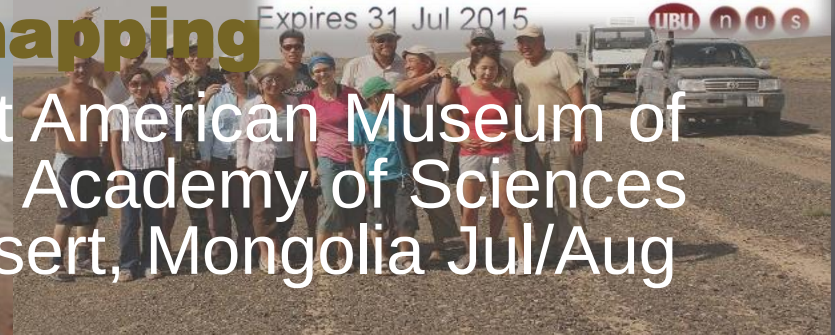

Overseas student's success overshadowed by fees debt

PADDINGTON Academy pupil Maral Ganbold was elated when she gained the A-level results she needed to be accepted on her chosen university course.

The 18-year-old achieved A* grade in maths, A in further maths and C in economics, to secure her place to study actuarial science at Cass Business School.

But her joy was short lived after discovering she would have to pay fees topping £30,000 because she was classified as an overseas student.

Maral's status resulted from the fact she moved to Maida Vale from Mongolia three years ago on her father's student visa and has still not been given permanent residence.

Hit with such high university costs, she is now at a loss to work out how she will afford to pay for her course.

Her teachers at Paddington Academy have tried to help, but to no avail.

"When I found this out my teachers tried to find me a scholarship," she said. "We wrote

hundreds of letters. My father is trying to pay for the first year but I'm not sure what's going to happen in my second and third year. It's been really stressful."

Maral, who came to London with very little English, entered Paddington Academy when she was 16 and completed her Year 10 and Year 11 studies in just one year.

"I didn't have a computer at home so I used to study at school until 7pm or 8pm in the evening to get my coursework done," she recalls.

"And my holidays were always at school so I could use the computers and books."

However, she now fears all her talents will go to waste if she cannot find the money to pay for her fees.

Her father, who works as a chef while studying, only has limited

resources and still has to support her mother, 12-year-old sister and five-year-old brother as well as Maral.

Another student from City of Westminster College knows the struggles of studying abroad.

Rachel Dbeis arrived in London five years ago from Beirut and she had not even finished her high school education.

But after deciding she wanted to become a doctor, the 23-year-old took on the challenge of studying four A-levels in one year and secured an offer to study medicine at Cambridge University.

While supporting herself financially, she studied tirelessly sitting a total of 23 exams this summer.

And last week her remarkable academic endurance was finally rewarded when she received her results - three A grades in

physics, maths and biology and a B in chemistry.

Speaking at her college campus in Paddington, Rachel said: "It was hard work but it was very rewarding."

Introduction: Distillation column is the most commonly used separation technology in chemical engineering industrial processes, such as petroleum refineries, petrochemical and chemical plants and natural gas processing. Thus, to design such columns effectively many calculations are done, one of which is to find the effectiveness by McCabe and Thiele method.

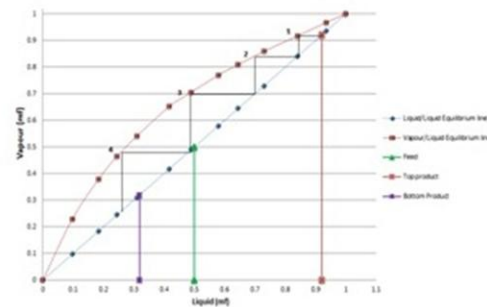
Aim: The experiment was performed to find the number of theoretical plates of a laboratory scale distillation column, in order to have a firm understanding of which factors in the distillation column is influencing the increase or decrease of the plates, which then determines the effectiveness of columns.

Result: The number of theoretical plates in this distillation column is found to be 5 at the condition of infinite reflux ratio. The composition of cyclohexane/toluene solutions became rich in toluene and less in cyclohexane the refractive index increased. Composition and refractive index is found to have linear relationship.
